He also let us know to connect with you as our house was flooded during the storm. My family was evacuated out of our home during the storm. A couple fireman were able to get to our home with a raft for our children to ride on while we walked through chest high water in the neighborhood. From there we were taken to a shelter and one of the other teachers at LSA was able to pick us up to stay with them. We were not able to get back to our house for 3-4 days to assess the damage. From there we have had help from our church ripping out floors, walls, cabinets, and appliances.
